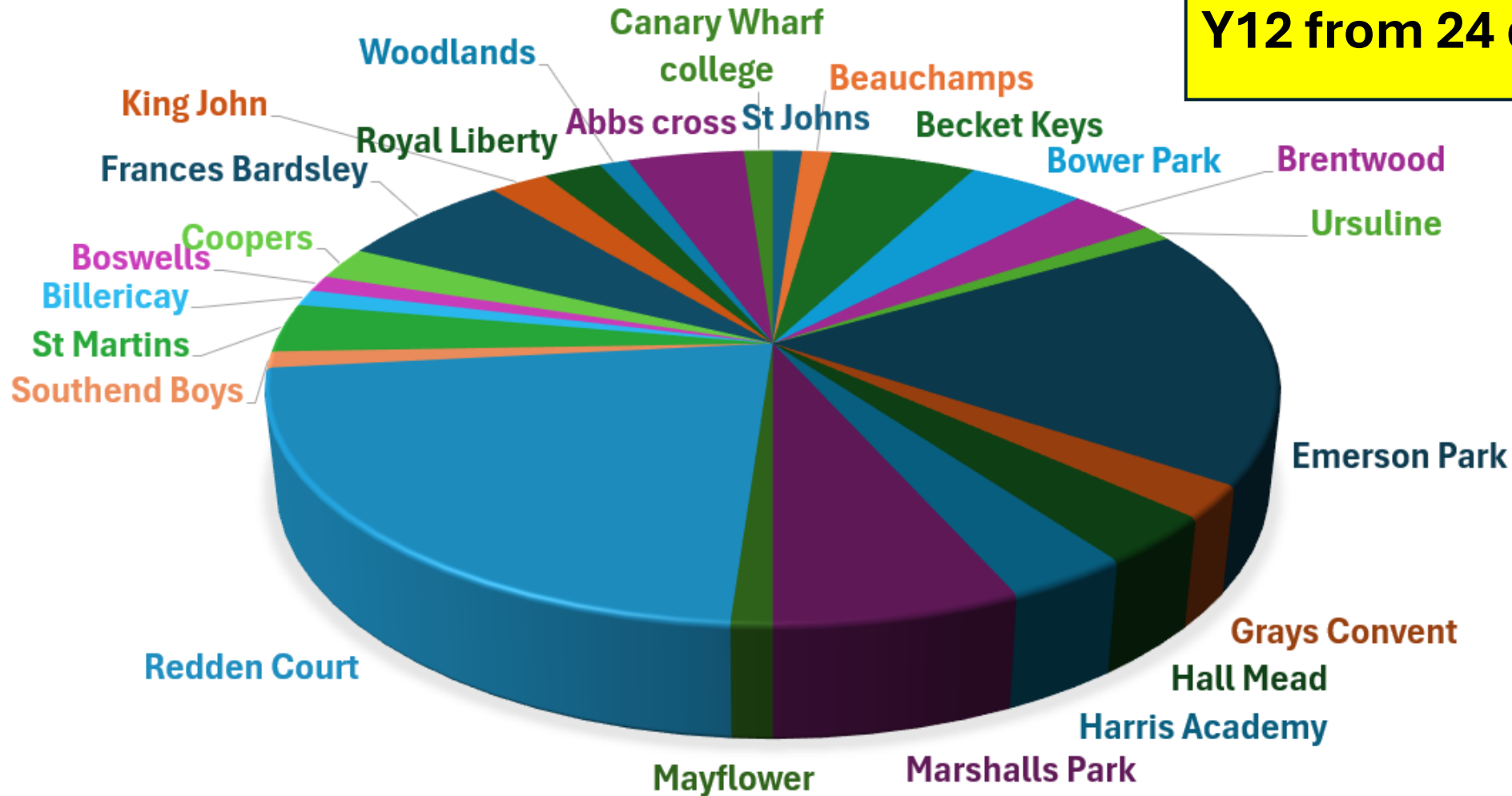
# 2024 Sixth Form Achievement

- ✓ 4 Students achieved straight A\*s across all subjects
- ✓ 26 students did not receive grades lower than a B
- ✓ The majority of our BTEC students achieved DDD or higher
- ✓ 3 ex-students are currently in their first year at **Oxford** and **Cambridge**, another ex-student is in their 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- ✓ 55% of students continued into university
- ✓ A growing number of students have secured apprenticeships

- Extra-curricular opportunities

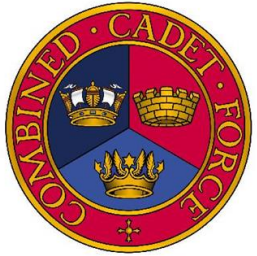


# Shenfield Academies
