2024 Sixth Form Achievement

- √ 4 Students achieved straight A*s across all subjects
- √ 26 students did not receive grades lower than a B
- √ The majority of our BTEC students achieved DDD or higher
- √3 ex-students are currently in their first year at <u>Oxford</u> and <u>Cambridge</u>, another ex-student is in their 3rd year
- √55% of students continued into university
- ✓ A growing number of students have secured apprenticeships
